Arrive Early. To Everything! Did I mention, Arrive Early? And I don't just mean five minutes before an event starts. We're talking 30 minutes to an hour depending on how desperate you are to see it and how close to the front you want to be. Also, most likely, many of the panels are held in low capacity rooms and you may not even get to enter the room if you're late. And this doesn't just pertain to panels and fan events, when we

say everything, we mean everything from food to music concerts to even picking up your badge to get into the show. This of course assumes you were smart enough to register early also so you saved \$\$\$ and are making it easier to get into the show. If you get to registration late, you could wait between one and three hours in the queue, just to get into the next queue wherever your last name falls.
